As part of the end of term parties and as a reward for the children's hard work, we are allowing children to bring in their electronic games; such as a handheld/portable gaming system, mobile phone or tablet. We are excited about giving children this opportunity as technology has become an essential part of education and everyday life. The use of electronic devices in the classroom is a privilege and we expect our pupils to use the devices in appropriate ways. We will not be providing them with the school's Wi-Fi password and therefore any 3G/4G facility will need to be turned off. To ensure the security of any equipment your child must hand in their device to their class teacher who will lock it away during break times. The children must take responsibility for the use of the device during the celebration. As I am sure you will agree, messaging, making calls, taking pictures or videos or any use of social media sites is prohibited whilst the children are using their devices in school. They will be able to use their devices to play pre-loaded games, which do not require the use of internet. It is certainly not required for your child to have an electronic game to bring in school as there will be many other activities which are equally rewarding.
