Success Criteria:

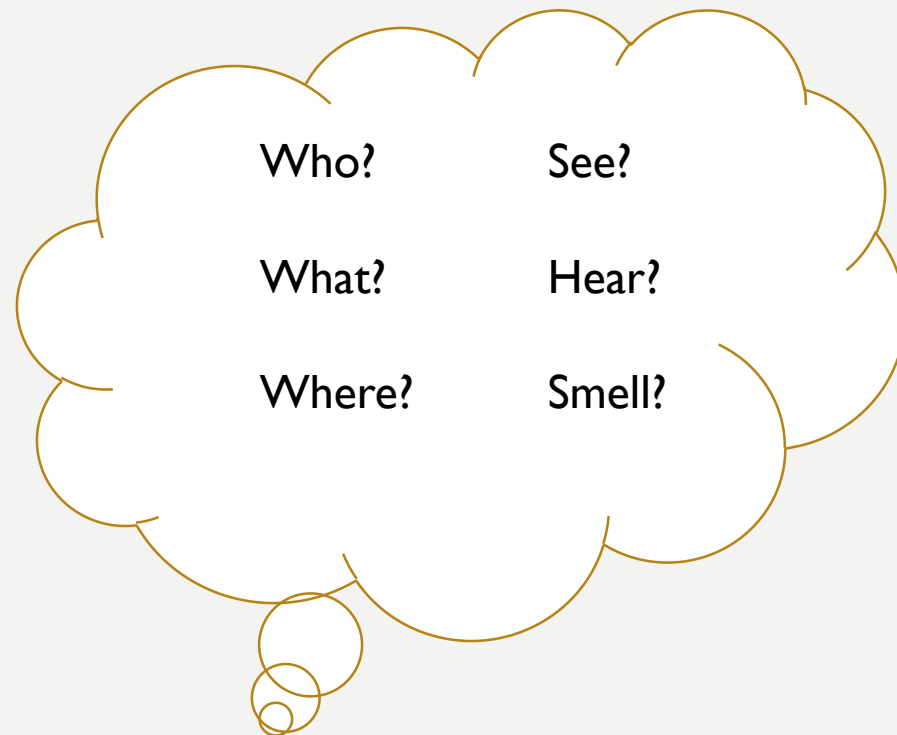
- I can use my brainstorm to write verses about my abandoned place.
