This year the theme of the competition is 'Choosing to Read'. Children can interpret this in any way they like in order to celebrate the joy that comes from choosing to read.

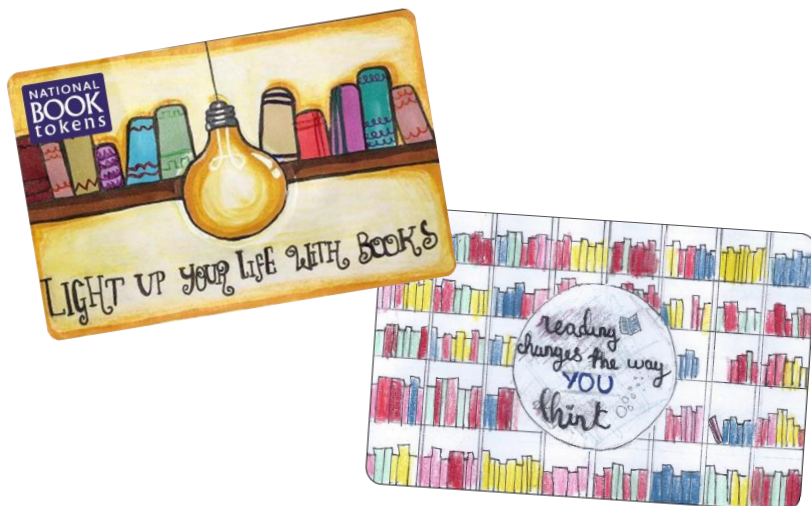
### Questions to think about before you begin your design:
