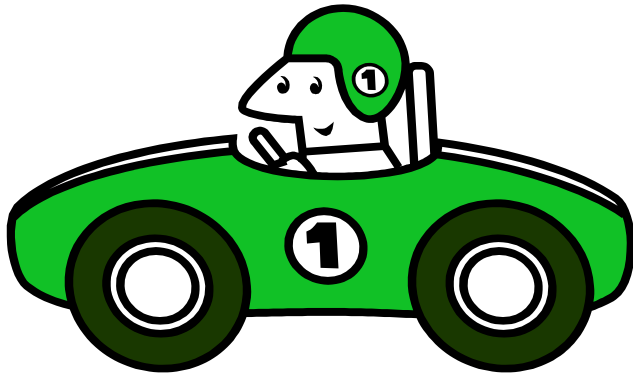

Don't forget to use your senses

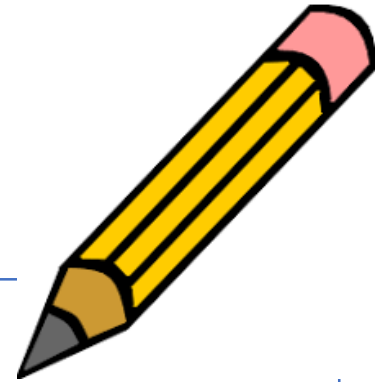
How does it make you feel?
