


Year 4 - Home Learning Grid – Spring 2

Below are 15 home learning tasks for your child to complete during the half term. There are 5 tasks for Maths and English and 5 creative tasks to choose from. Each child is expected to complete six tasks over the term. Two from each curriculum area.

We appreciate that some weekends are busier than others; therefore, we are giving you the flexibility to complete tasks in your own time. Instead of checking weekly we have decided to take homework books in over half term to monitor progress with home learning.

Please ensure your child returns their home learning book to school in the last week of term.
