Below are 15 home learning tasks for you to complete during the half term. There are 5 tasks for Maths and English and 5 creative tasks to choose from. Each child is expected to complete **ten tasks** over the half term. Please ensure you return your home learning book to school in the last week of half term.

Include 5 interesting facts with eye-catching pictures.
Letter writing Write a letter to Miss Digweed about ways we can improve our school environment. Think about: saving energy, recycling and maintaining play equipment. Poetry Write a poem about your goals and dreams for your life. This could be about a dream job or dream lifestyle.
