Below are 15 home learning tasks for you to complete during the half term. There are 5 tasks for Maths and English and 5 creative tasks to choose from. You are expected to complete **ten tasks** over the half term. Please ensure you return your home learning book to school in the last week of half term.

English	Maths	Creative
Fact File Research which celebrities and well-known people are refugees. Pick one person and create a fact file about their life and their journey. Character description Select a character of your choice, perhaps from your favourite film or TV show, and create a detailed description of them. Each wall is 4.58m in length. What is the perimeter of the cafe? At the bakery there are 63 cakes on display. $\frac{3}{9}$ of them are cupcakes. $\frac{4}{7}$ of them are pastries. The rest are doughnuts. How many are doughnuts?	Well-being Complete a physical activity outside in the sunshine. You could go for a walk in the park, play a sport with friends/family or practice your cricket skills.
Poem Create a poem about the Kraken in our class text. This could be a cinquain poem or a rhyming poem. You may have to wait until we have read up to this point in our book to complete this task.
