To All Parents/Carers of Year 6,


The School Nursing Service recently visited your child's school to undertake their height/weight (and vision screening from March 2023) as part of the <u>National Childhood Measurement</u>

<u>Programme</u> (Dept Health and Social Care, 2023). Your child would <u>not</u> have been told their measurements and would <u>not</u> have been able to see the numbers of the digital scales used for the NCMP.



To view your child's results please revisit SchoolScreener. If you did not withdraw consent (opt-out) your child may still have been screened, parents/carers are routinely given 2 weeks to consider this option. If you would like to view your child results and did not register initially, please do click on the link below and then follow the Parent Portal instructions.

A member of the school nursing team may be in contact with you to discuss the results after the screening.
