Assessment

<u>Type of assessment</u>	<u>How it informs planning, teaching and learning</u>
In lesson assessment	Teachers will observe pupils throughout the lessons and address challenges, misconceptions or areas for improvement and address them through verbal feedback during the lesson, either individually, groups or as a whole class.
Swimming assessment	Swimming is taught annually as an intensive block for Y5 and 6 through a swimming pool on site. Y3 and 4 have a few swimming sessions each year. Swimming is assessed by the swimming instructor and pupils who are not reaching the expected standard by Y6 are provided with additional swimming sessions.
Termly assessment	Individual success criteria for lessons are used to assess the extent to which pupils met the learning intention and whether they are working towards, at or with greater depth in relation to the expected standard. These statements are used formatively week to week, to inform the retrieval and warm up aspects of lessons in order to best support all pupils' development.
