<u>Type of assessment</u>	<u>How it informs planning, teaching and learning</u>
In lesson assessment	Retrieval practice is used at the start of each lesson to identify the learning that pupils have retained. This is used to inform planning. Teacher's use their professional judgement to assess pupil's learning during a lesson. From this the following lesson should be adapted to address any misconceptions and to recap any key areas.

Pupil voice

- The most recent pupils survey showed that pupils are feeling the benefit of the two-year cycle and feel that they are able to build on their learning in the second year (year 5 to year 6). Pupils would like more use of video clips and physical resources to support their learning.
- In response to this, a bank of suitable video clips is being created to support the teaching of RE in KS 2. Physical resources are being sourced and an audit of resources will be made available to staff.

Staff surveys

- Staff would like resources to support their lessons and an increase in physical resources available.
- In response to this a meeting with Jigsaw RE scheme representatives to discuss if they can provide appropriate resources in line with our RE Curriculum. Physical resources and artefacts are being sourced when the budget allows. Resources will be borrowed from other settings when possible.
