# How we are keeping safe:

- ► Class 'bubbles' children will only interact with pupils from their own class.

## The School Day

This is what our school day usually looks like.

The areas in red are areas that may be subject to change due to government guidance.

We will provide more information about these areas before the start of term.

8:30 - 8:45	Pupils are dropped off and play on the playground. Supervised by school staff.
8:45 - 9:00	Registration and early morning activities
9:00 - 10:00	Maths
10:00 - 10:15	Play time
10:15 - 11:15	English
11:15 - 11:30	Assembly
11:30 - 12:00	Phonics / Guided reading
12:00 -12:20	Lunch in the diner. All pupils spend at least 20 minutes eating but can have more time if needed.
12:20 - 13:00	Playtime on the playground
13:00 - 14:00	Afternoon lesson 1 (Science, humanities, Art, DT, PE, Music, PSHE, RE)
14:00 - 15:15	Afternoon lesson 2 (Science, humanities, Art, DT, PE, Music, PSHE, RE)
15:15	Home time. Pupils collected from classroom door.

## Behaviour and Attitudes

The school has 3 main rules designed to promote good relationships and encourage respect.

#### These are:

- Follow instructions straight away
- Show good manners at all times
- Care for everyone and everything

Every pupil starts every day on a 'Good Day'.

IVERTASTIC	Awarded a Purple Star - logged on the Simply Behave Tracker.
OUTSTANDING	Awarded a Pink Star - logged on the Simply Behave Tracker.
SUPER	Awarded a Yellow Star - logged on the Simply Behave Tracker.
GOOD DAY	Where every child begins the day
LEVEL 1	Warning - Peg moved to Level 1
LEVEL 2	15 mins time out in the classroom and chn write a letter to parents/carer explaining the misdemeanour and apologising for it. Recorded by DHT.
LEVEL 3	1 hour time out with SLT, a letter home and the incident recorded by DHT. This behaviour could lead to an internal exclusion – parents called by SLT.

\*This is our *usual* uniform expectations.

In September, PE kits will not be need initially. We ask that pupils wear comfortable, black shoes or trainers that can be used for PE. We will be using outdoor areas including grass areas so please wear shoes or trainers that can get muddy.
