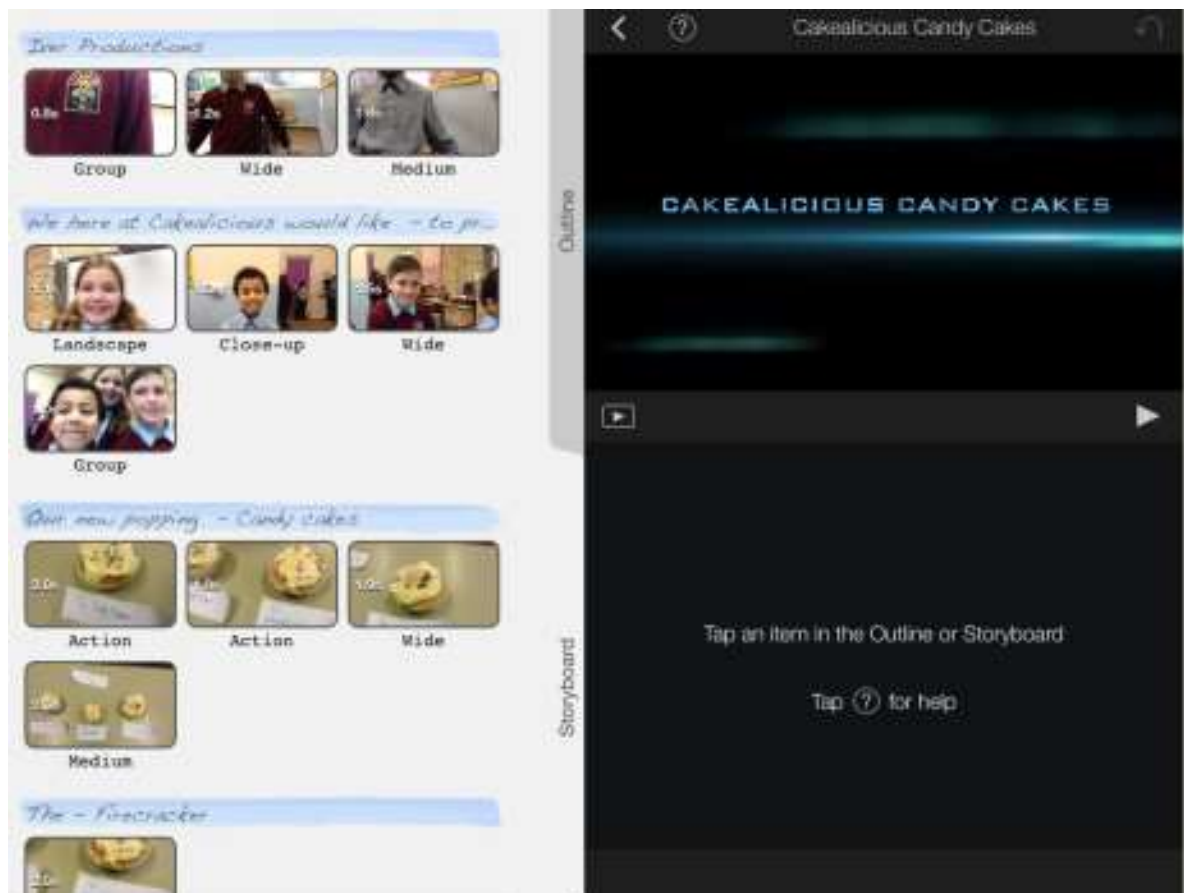
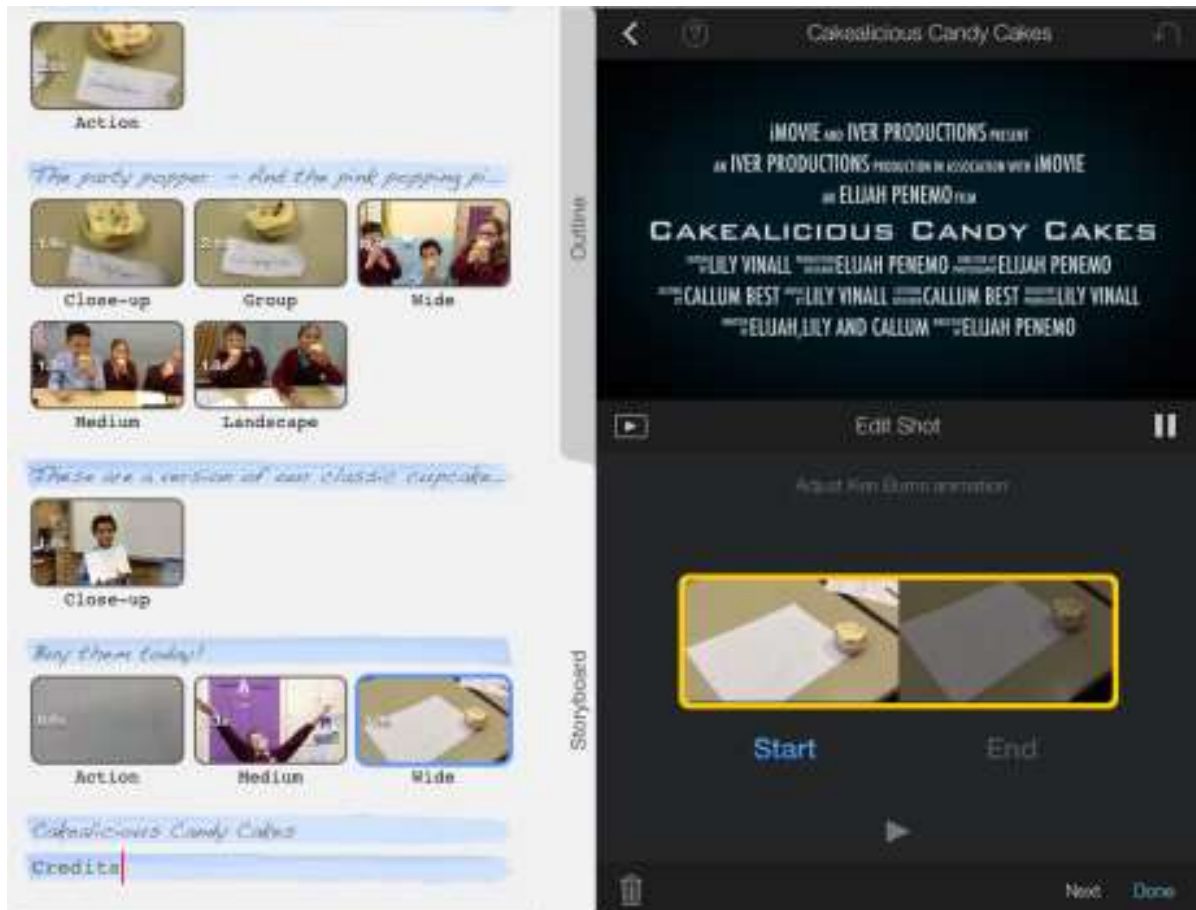
This week, we sent a letter to the parents of our Year 3 pupils about Victorian day.

Free school meals



**Does your
family
qualify?**

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 in state-funded schools in England are eligible for free school meals.

From Year 3 onwards, if your family receives one or more of the following, your son or daughter may be eligible for free school meals:

- **Income Support**
- **Income based Job Seekers Allowance**
- **Income based Employment and Support Allowance**
- **The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit**
- **Child tax credit and no working tax credit with an income of less than £16,190.**
- **Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.**
