Our lovely choir are currently on tour ... They have visited Croft House, Sunnyside and the Rotary club at Pinewood Hotel!




## **Pupils Left After** 3.30pm

Any children left in our care after school hours will incur an extra £2 on top of their club fees. We will charge late fees of £5 per 15 minutes after 6pm.
