This year, we will be taking part in the National Schools Partnership's Big Battery Hunt! The focus will be on recycling and so each child has been given their own box to fill with any empty, used batteries they may have lying around the house instead of putting them in the bin. Each year, over 20,000 tonnes of batteries end up in landfill sites across the UK. That's as heavy as about 4,000 elephants!
