Year 5 – have been looking at place value and how to round large numbers off. In English, they have finished writing a poem based on *The Journey*.

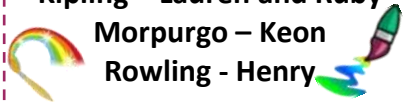
