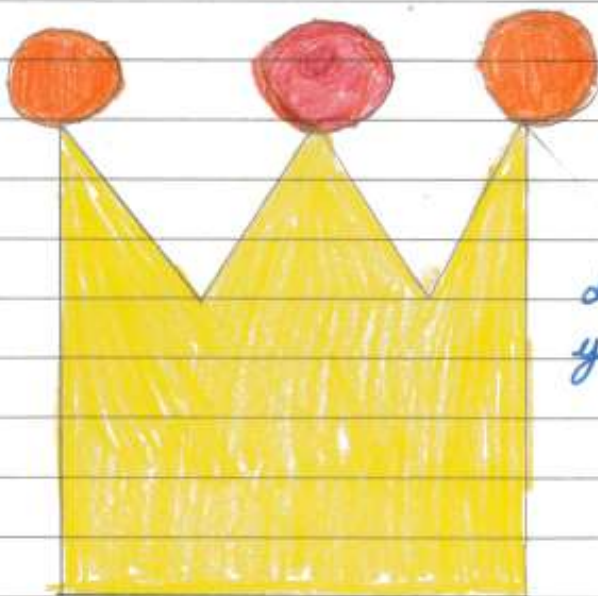
Rose!
