## **Secondary School Deadlines and 11+**

Online applications are being taken on the admissions section of the [www.bucks.cc.gov.uk](http://www.bucks.cc.gov.uk) website. The deadline for applications for first round allocations is 31<sup>st</sup> October however we recommend you get your applications in by 21<sup>st</sup> October to give the council time to acknowledge that they have received the application. Please note that **Grammar schools have set their deadline for moving into the area as 1<sup>st</sup> October** but the deadline for their applications is still 31<sup>st</sup> October. The Year 6 11+ transfer test results will be sent out on 16<sup>th</sup> October.

## **Eligibility for Free School Meals**

I am delighted to say, all of our pupils who took part did fantastically well and earned either certificates or badges in their level 2 training!

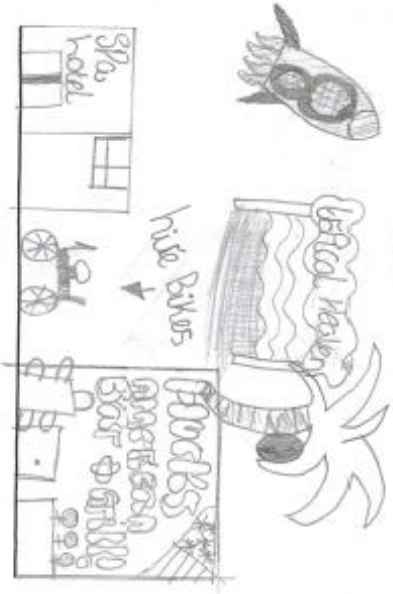

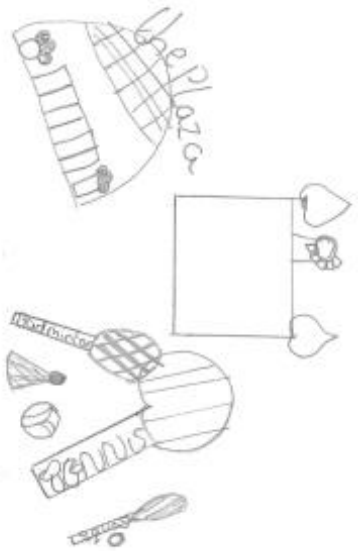
