## The Vident Volcanoes!

What is a volcano and how are they formed?

Have you ever been intrigued with Volcanoes? If not you're in luck because I'm about to tell you everything about them. Now, let's start! A volcano is a hole in the crust of the Earth leading to the mantle where molten rock (Magma) erupts out of the hole. Each time it erupts the magma dries into rock on the side with slowly forming a huge cone shape.

The Earth is made up of several different layers. The top is the crust it's approximately 5-70km thick and 20c-40c. Secondly, there's the mantle which is 2900 km thick and made from molten rock and 500c. Next, we have the outer core which is 2300km thick and made from molten metal. Now we have the center of the Earth called the inner core which is
