

Year 3 Curriculum Map

AUTUMN TERM



AS SCIENTISTS

We will learn about how plants grow, observe the stages a plants lifecycle and explore how seeds are formed and dispersed. We will explore human and animal skeletons and investigate how muscles work, explaining how these protect and enable movement.

AS GEOGRAPHERS

We will learn about our local area discovering human and physical features. We will name and locate capital cities in the UK and identify and compare rivers and mountains in the UK.

AS ARTISTS

We will explore the elements of Art looking at line, colour, value, shape, texture and space.

AS LINGUISTS

We will locate France and other French speaking countries on a map and be able to tell someone what our name is and ask someone how they feel. We will also describe the seasons on French.

AS DESIGNERS

We will investigate a range of puppets and their features. We will plan, design and use our sewing skills to make our own puppet.

AS COMPUTER SCIENTISTS

We will explore coding by using different timers, repeat command and nesting. Through online safety we will learn how to make a safe password, how the internet can be used to help us communicate effectively and understand a 'spoof' website.

AS THINKERS

We will explore the different religions in our community and the beliefs that they hold including places of worship and their important features. We will explore what 'being me' means and the impact of our actions. We will understand our differences and celebrate them.

AS HISTORIANS

We will explore Prehistoric Britain through the Stone, Bronze and Iron ages. We will find out about early humans through the Palaeolithic and the Neolithic period, exploring how people lived.

AS ATHLETES

We will explore football and tag rugby showing some ball control with accuracy. We will also use our body to create different pathways, directions and shapes through gymnastic actions.
