Continents



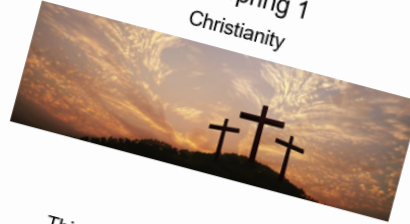
This half term's objectives are:
