

The Roman Empire lasted for over 1000 years. When the Roman civilization began in 753 B.C. the Egyptian civilization had already been going for








# Timelines


# Timelines

---

- **BCE (Before the Common Era)** – The bigger the number the **EARLIER** the year. For example, **2345 BCE** happened before **24 BCE**
- **CE (Common Era)**- – The bigger the number the **LATER** the year. For example, **1645 CE** happened before **1945 CE**.

1914 CE – 1918 CE

- **Queen Victoria** reigned from 1819 CE to 1901 CE
  - **World War 1** occurred during 1914 CE to 1918 CE
- 1914 > 1901 therefore World War 1
